Call to Order

Mary Cross There were 9 Board members and 3 committee or general members present. The meeting was called to order at about 11:05am.

Minutes of November 7, 2021

John Cuzik – edited by Mary Cross Minutes were approved with spelling corrections suggested by Roger Lane. Mary indicated that the Board is tasked with editing the draft minutes sent out with the agendas prior to the Board Meeting.

Chairpersons' Reports

Treasury

Roger Lane Income: dues \$235, raffle tickets: \$70. Expenses: November Speaker \$150, plant purchased from speaker \$80, December rent \$150, raffle plants \$144, catered meal for December membership meeting \$2,994.20. It was determined to table a new price for raffle plants until the next meeting. We need 30 plants per raffle. (This speaker's plants will be used at the December meeting.)

These interests have come together in a wonderful way during my botanical explorations of the western US and Mexico, and portions of South America, Africa, Madagascar and the Middle East.
