#### **Chairpersons' Reports**

Treasury

 Roger Lane reported corrections to the November Holiday Party/Auction report: Expenses increased \$34.49, and expenses to vendors - \$2,323.50 and Total income increased to \$1,125.50.

January Income - \$155 for dues, \$66 for Raffle. Expenses – Speaker \$250.00, plants \$579.00, raffle plants \$135.00, February rent \$150.00, gift baskets \$80.00, Insurance \$228.00

-Ad hoc investment Committee Report: Lou Falek reported that the committee met.

After a discussion, the Board decided to invest \$15,000 in the S&P 500. Tom will send Roger the application for Fidelity. It was decided that checks of \$5,000 or more will from now on require two signatures, Treasurer and President.

-There was a discussion about creating some way for members to pay their dues on-line. Peter indicated we could use the "Square" process he used at the Fall Sale which can take Paypal/Apple Pay/ credit cards etc. Nancy, Roger, Lyn, and Peter will formalize the process and the info will be made available on the Website and all publications in the future. Thy will report back at the June meeting.

-Suggested Budget for 2022 – Roger indicated he would provide that next month.

#### Membership

Lyn MacDonald reported that she had received \$1,055 in dues for 2022 so far, including 22 new members. 91 people have paid and 36 are still unpaid. She will try new ways to connect with them and get them renewed.

#### **Sunshine Committee**

Cheryl Albert wasn't present but reported that there were no sick people at that time.

Annie Wolfe wasn't present, but the Board approved that for the February Membership Meeting Stan and Naomi can do a talk about soil mixtures and including a demonstration about re-potting. -The Mini-Show plants - Stan Verkler reported that the Mini-Show plants for February will be Farocactus in the cactus category and Pelargoniums in the succulent category.

There was a discussion about opening the sales to members on Friday afternoon some time. It was not known for sure when we can get the key but the desire was to open earlier on Friday morning so the vendors can be ready and set up for sales to members who help set-up on Friday afternoon for about 2 hours. Times will be Friday (sale) 2-4pm?, Saturday 9-5pm and Sunday 9-3pm. Annie Wolf volunteered to organize the food for vendors and volunteers others can volunteer to bring certain dishes or supplies.
